Educational Philosophy

Class Expectations

Tests and Quizzes

Tests will be given at the end of each unit. Make up tests must be arranged with the teacher and taken either before or after school. Tests must be made up within a week of the day the test was given. After this time any student who has not taken the test will receive a zero.

Quizzes will be given at the beginning of the class period. If a student is tardy or absent they cannot make up the quiz. The quizzes will cover the material discussed the previous day or a reading assignment given as homework.

Participation

It is important for students to be in class on time and use class time wisely. Each student will start out with 100 points for participation at the beginning of the term. Students will lose participation points by excessive talking, rude or disruptive behavior, or being off task during lecture or class work time.

Notebook

In this class students will be expected to keep their notes and assignments organized in a 3 ring binder. Notebooks should be brought to class every day. I will collect and grade the notebooks at the end of each unit. The notebook will be returned the next class period. If the student is absent when the notebook is collected they need to bring me the notebook within a week so I can check it and give them the points.

Attendance

We will follow the school attendance policy.

Homework

Homework assignments are due at the beginning of the class period. After that time it will be considered late. I will accept late homework assignments for half credit up to two weeks after it was collected. After that time I will not accept the homework. If a student is absent, it is their responsibility to get the homework, complete it and turn it in within one week of the absence or it will be considered late.

Labs

Labs are an important part of physics. They give students an opportunity to experiment with the concepts they are learning. Labs cannot be made up. If a student is absent on the day of the lab they will need to check with me to get an alternate assignment. One lab will be dropped per term.

Early Enrichment Schedule

In this class, you will be expected to take advantage of the Early Enrichment time before school starts. I will post in my classroom a monthly calendar showing the days and times I will be available. The ways we will use the time in the morning are as follows:

- All makeup work will be done in the morning. You do not need to schedule a time as long as I am available that morning.
- If you have a NG in this class, you will be expected to do your attendance school make-up in the mornings, with me, doing the work you missed.
- Before tests we will have optional, morning, study sessions. These will be a great way to get ready for the test.
- If you are absent or know you will be absent you need to come in during the morning and get the make-up work.
- If you have questions or concerns about your grade you need to come in during the morning to discuss them with me.
